Indiana's Access To Public Records Act (APRA)

Damon Leichty of the South Bend office was mentioned in several articles published by [ABC News](#), the [South Bend Tribune](#), [WSBT 22](#) and the [Chicago Tribune](#). Damon, of the South Bend office, represented the University of Notre Dame in a case of first impression for Indiana courts: whether a private university's campus police department is subject to Indiana's Access to Public Records Act (APRA). ESPN has filed a suit claiming that the Notre Dame Security Police Department is a "public agency" under APRA and required to produce records on hundreds of student-athletes. The articles highlight oral argument on the university's motion to dismiss the case.
