GRAND RAPIDS – In honor of Veterans Day, Barnes & Thornburg teamed up with Bell's Brewery to host a celebration for Grand Rapids area veterans. This community event was held on Nov. 6 at the Grand Rapids Art Museum and included local food, music and programming featuring local veterans.
