DACA Status/Employment Card Filing Temporarily Reinstated

January 15, 2018 | Atlanta | Chicago | Columbus | Dallas | Delaware | Elkhart | Fort Wayne | Grand Rapids | Indianapolis | Los Angeles | Minneapolis | New York | South Bend

According to the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services webpage, filing for Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) status renewal and associated employment authorization documents has temporarily resumed, due to a federal court order, on the same basis as prior to Sept. 5, 2017. Eligible applicants who may have missed the initial filing window may consider filing as soon as possible.
