

NLRB Impounds Ballets Cast By Duquesne University Adjunct-Faculty

The National Labor Relations Board has impounded ballets cast by Duquesne University's adjunct-faculty, seeking representation by the United Steelworkers. The decision to impound the ballets followed the University's Motion asserting that the Catholic university is exempt from the jurisdiction of the NLRB as a religious institution.
